2. Novice Horse – not to have won more than three 1st classes – any breed/height/type
3. Veteran – 15 years and over – any breed/height/type
4. Thelwell, shetlands or miniatures
5. Cob – Any height/breed/type. Traditional / Maxi/Hairy / Hogged etc
6. M & M Small Breeds – registered or unregistered
7. M & M Large Breeds – registered or unregistered
8. Coloured Horse / Pony – Any age / height / type – skewbald, piebald, spots, palominos & roans, duns
9. Bays, Blacks, greys & Chestnuts – Any age, height, type
10. Best Pony In hand – any type / breed / 14.2hh & under

20. First Ridden – Riders 12 years & under. Will not be expected to canter in a group and canter is optional in individual show
21. Novice Ridden – Mare or Gelding 4 year & old any height, type, breed, not to have won more than two 1st places. No Cantering as a group & canter is optional in your individual show. Lead rein permitted.
22. M & M Small Breeds – open to registered & unregistered 4 years & over
23. M & M Large Breeds – open to registered & unregistered 4 years & over
24. Cobs – open to any height / type Traditional, Maxi, hairy, hogged. 4 years & over
25. Veteran Horse & Pony – 15 years & over. Any height, type, breed. Lead rein permitted
26. Coloured Horse & Pony - Any breed/ height / type – skewbald, piebald, spots, palominos & roans, duns. 4 years & over
27. Ridden Horse - over 14.2hh open to Hunter, hack, cob, riding horse, TB
28. Ridden Pony – 14.2hh & under

Show Rules:

1. Judging times are accurate as possible but can be subject to change.
2. All ridden ponies or horses must be 4 years old & over.
3. Riding Hats; riders must wear a riding hat whilst mounted on horseback at all times and they must wear correctly fitted protective headgear which complies with the latest British Standard. Handlers of ponies/horses in the In hand classes who are under 14 years old must wear properly secured hats to current British Standards.
4. Bridles, unless otherwise stated any suitable bridle may be used. Ponies shown on the lead rein may only be shown in a snaffle bridle.
5. Insurance, it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure all property and livestock on the showground or elsewhere which is his own, or which he is responsible including public liability insurance.
6. Dogs are permitted on the showground but must be kept on a lead at all times. Please clean up after your dog.
7. Please do not muck your trailer or horsebox out on the showground.
8. The show organizers have taken all responsible precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring. The show organizers will not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident, to any person, horse or property however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant has read and understood these terms and conditions
9. Entry fees are non-refundable. If the show has to be cancelled for any reason then every provision will be made to re-schedule.
10. The Judge's decision is final.
11. Objections, any exhibitor feeling aggrieved must take his protest in writing within one hour of the completion of judging of the class and pay a deposit to the secretary of £20.00. Objections will not be entertained from any person or organization not exhibiting in the same class as the animal to which the objection is raised.
12. NO WEARING OF FACE/BODY JEWELLERY in any classes.
13. In leading rein classes the lead rein must be attached to the noseband.
14. The show has a right to refuse entries with giving reason.
