The route is around our off-road grass tracks & optional cross country jumps ranging from 30cm-70cm.

You can choose either to ride the 3 mile, 5 mile or go round twice for 10 mile route.

- You may request an approximate time slot when entering and I will do my best to accommodate, obviously more precise time slots will be allocated on a first come first served.

- You will receive an email confirming your entry and start time or can confirm by phone if no email access
- Entries will close on Wednesday 24th June 2020

6. The ride starts & finishes at the same point, and the route will be marked.
7. When mounted, all riders MUST wear a riding hat to the current British Standard & Body Protectors are recommended.
